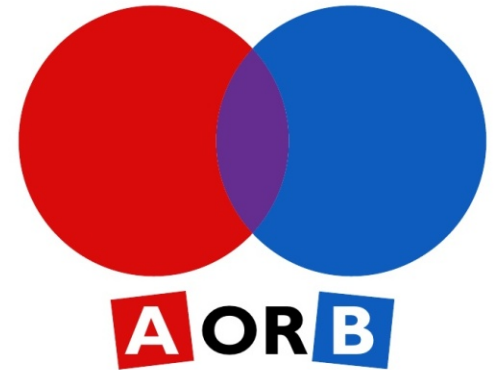


24. Jesus replied, “I will also ask you one question. If you answer me, I will tell you by what authority I am doing these things.

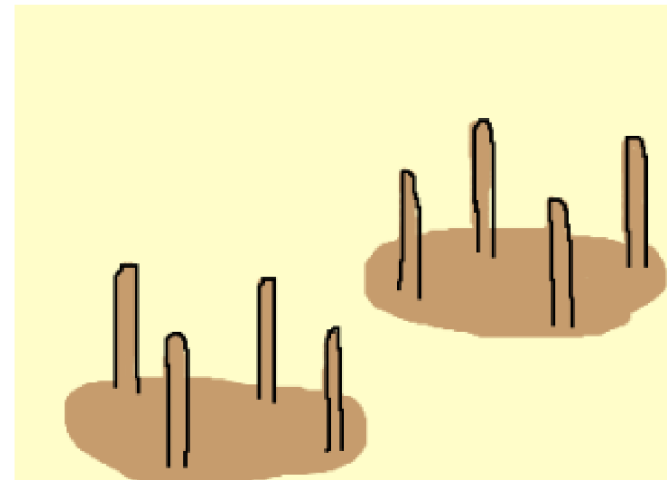
28. “What do you think? There was a man who had two sons. He went to the first and said, ‘Son, go and work today in the vineyard.’
