

# Colossians 2:13-15 (NLT)

- 13) You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins.
- 14) He cancelled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.
- 15) In this way, he disarmed<sup>1</sup> the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by his victory over them on the cross.

meaning that there is an obvious problem or difficult situation that people do not want to talk about.

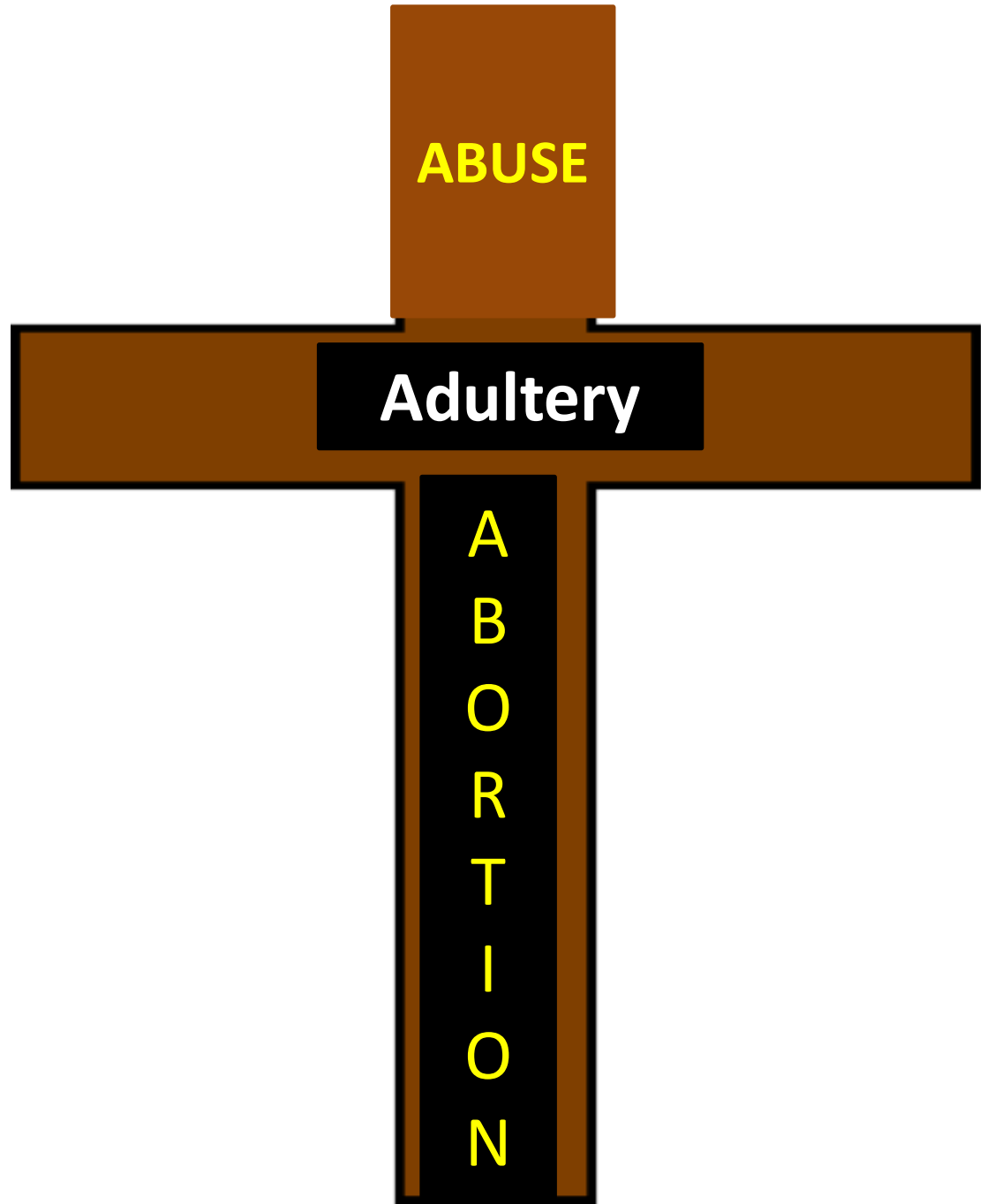
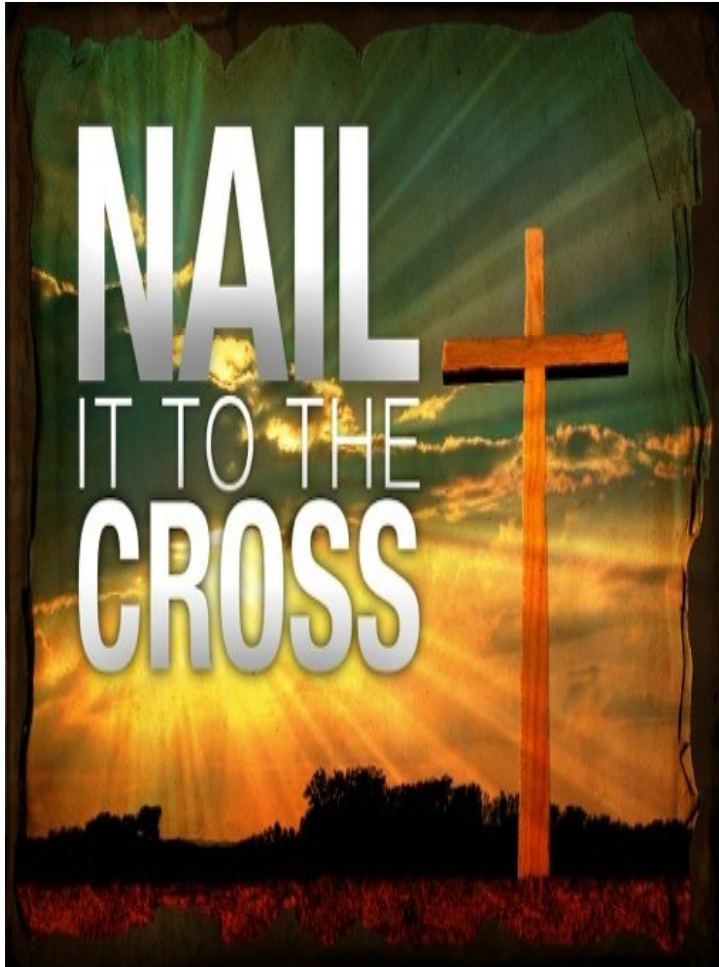


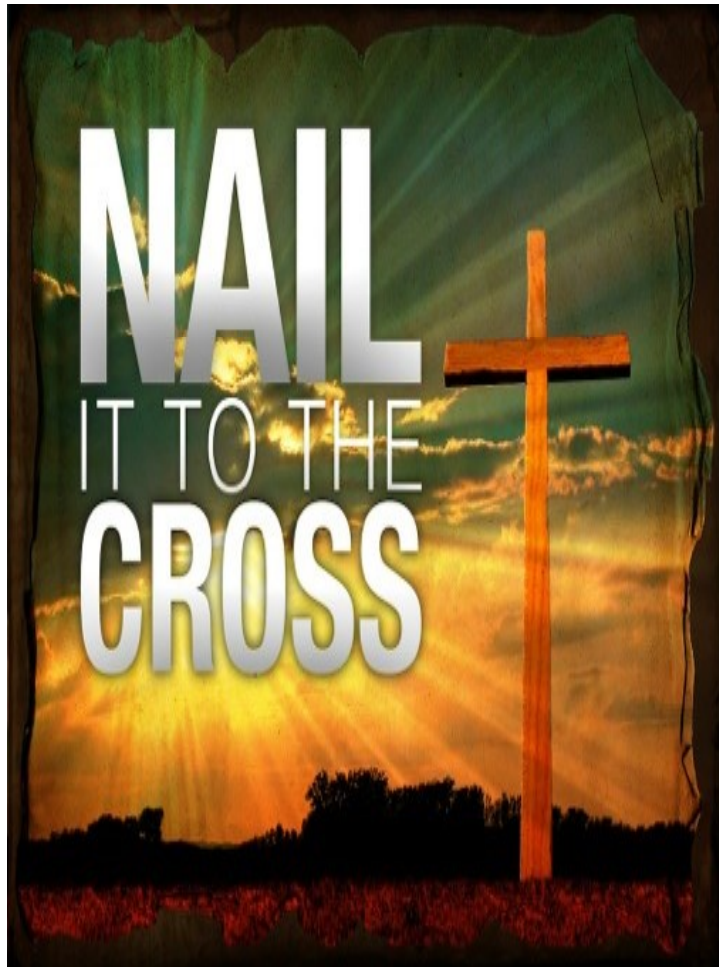

God wiped out the charges that were against us for disobeying the Law of Moses. He took them away and nailed them to the cross.



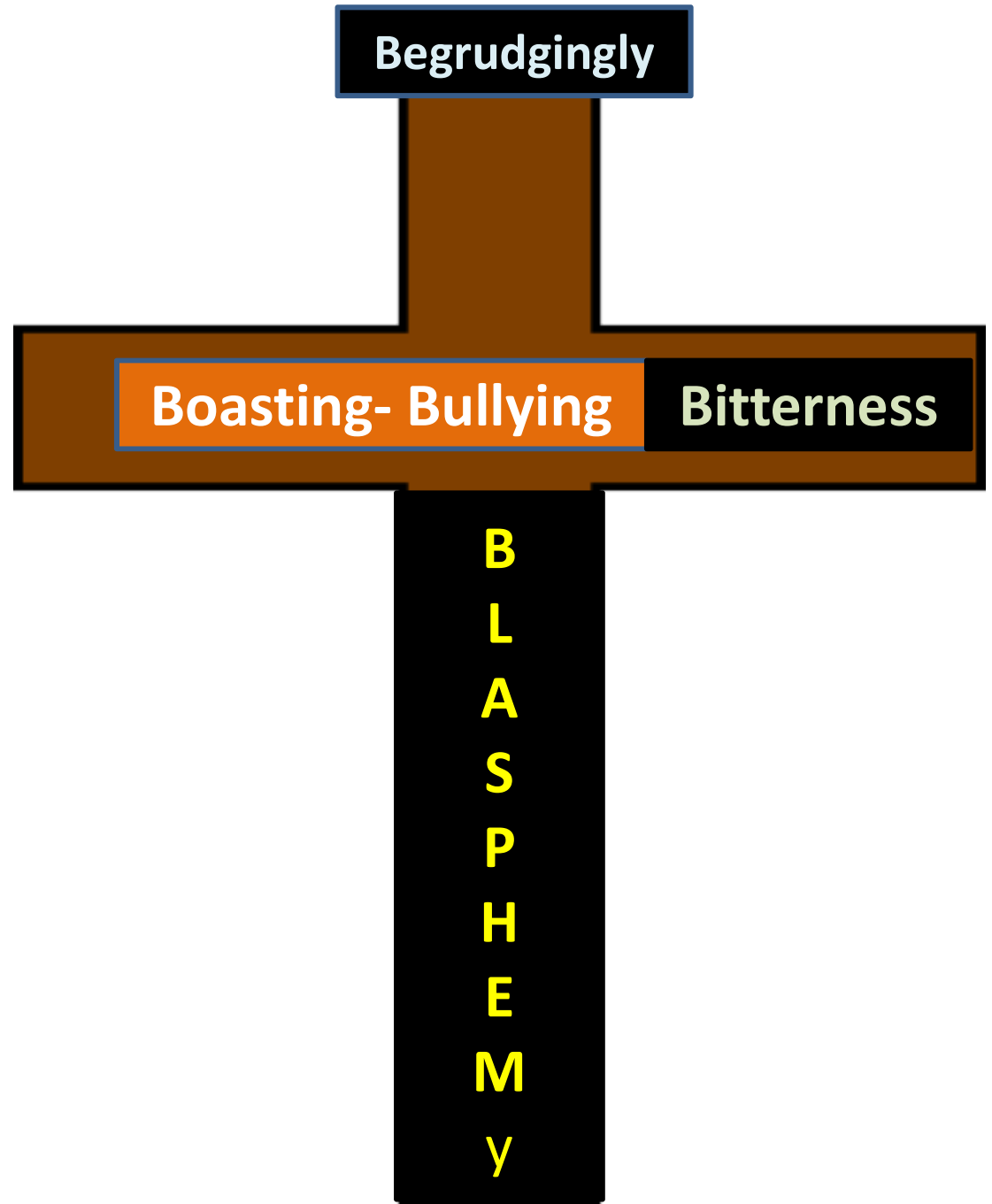
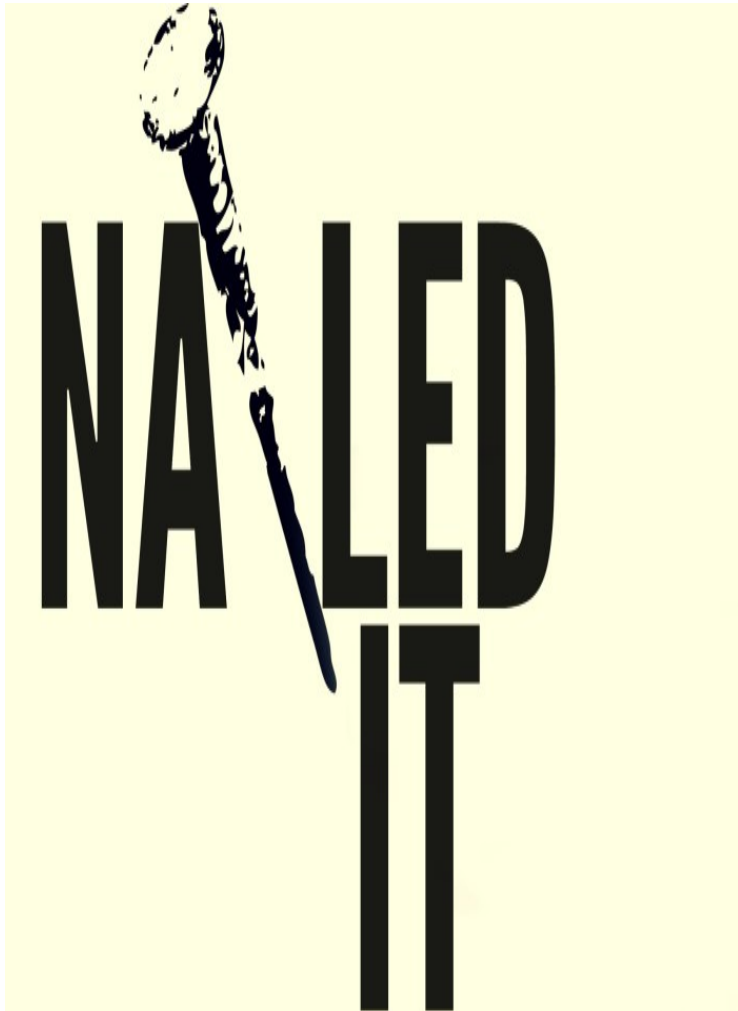
