

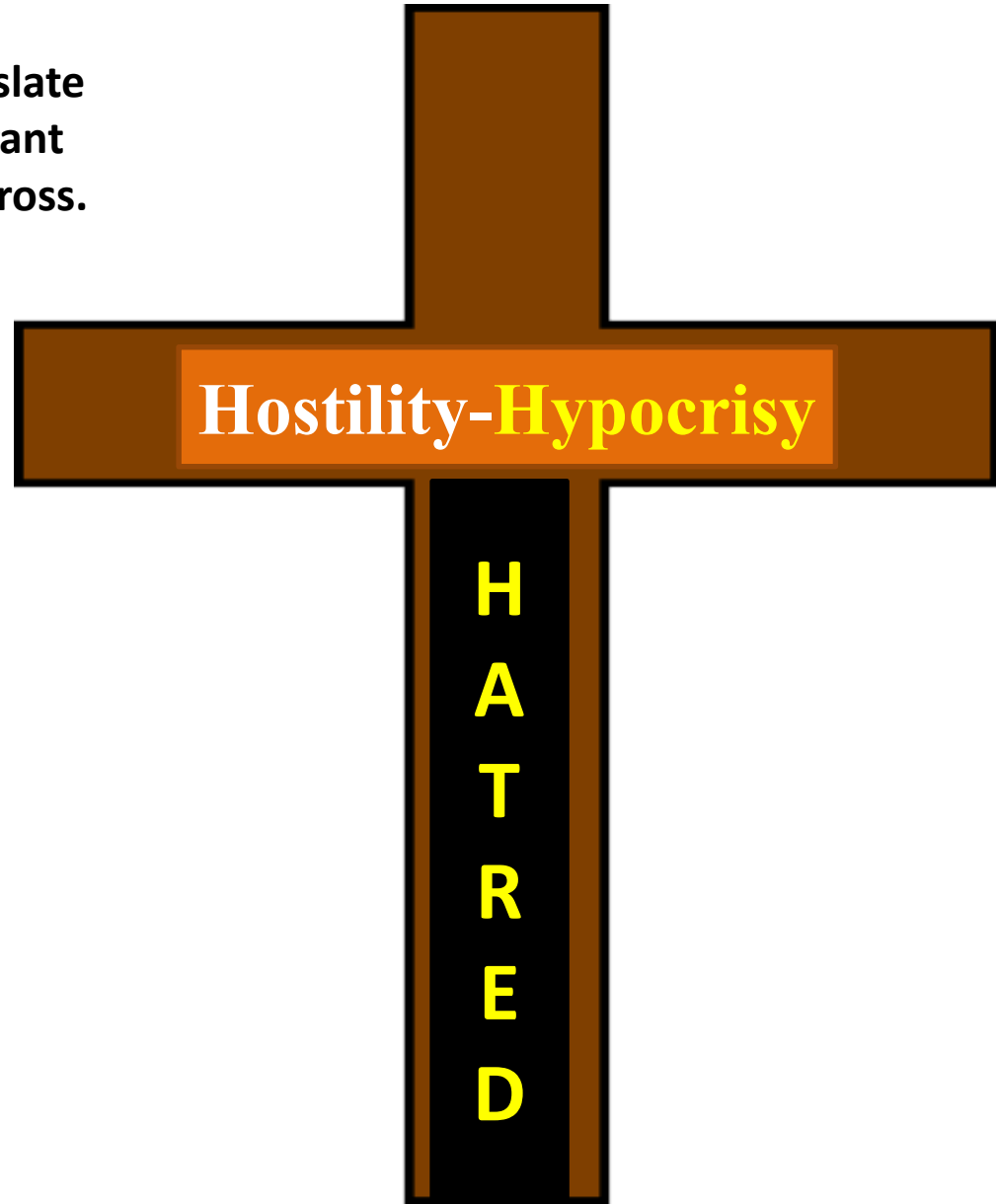
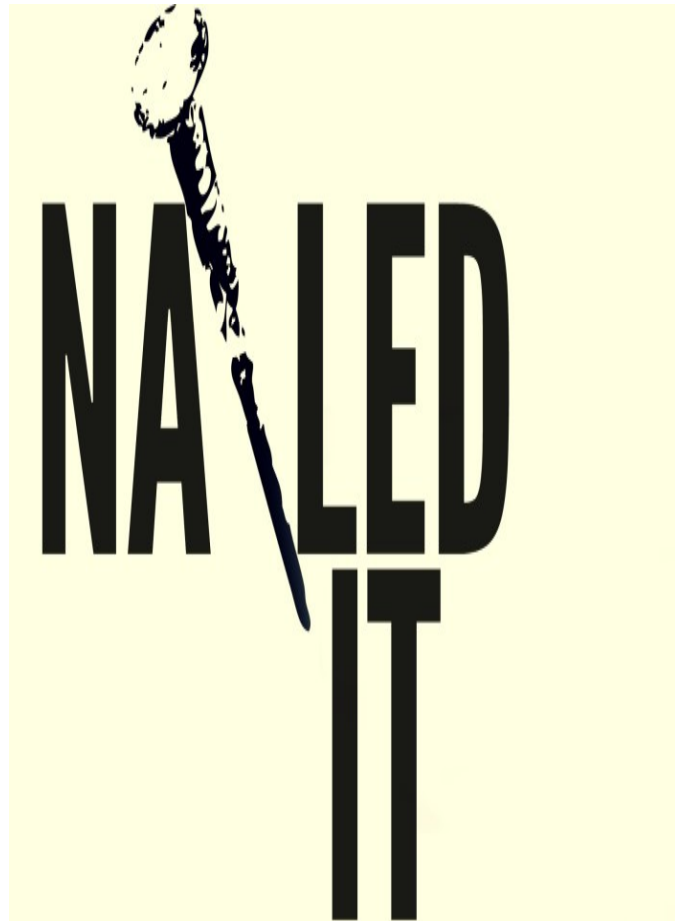

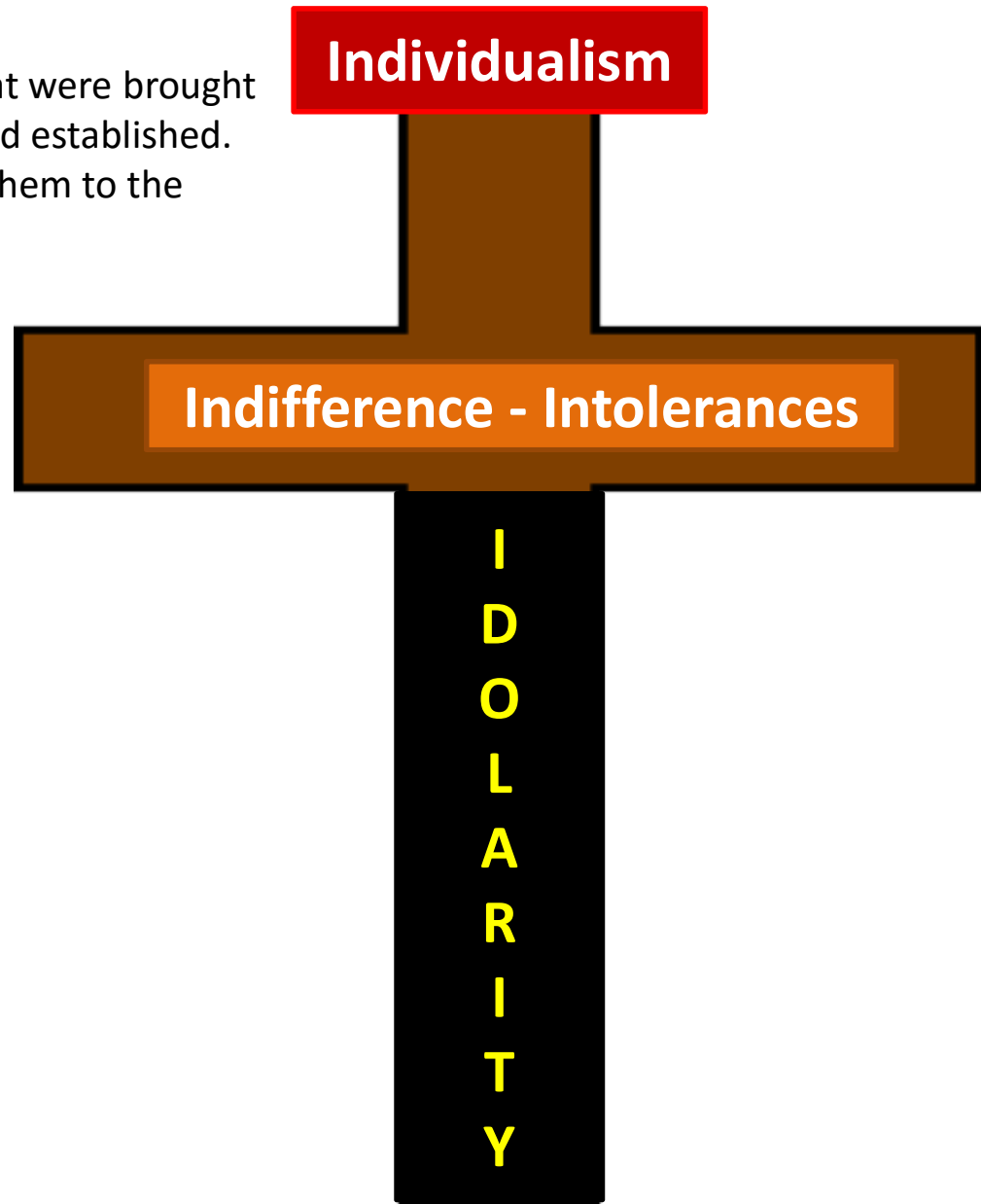
**Colossians 2:14- (MSG)**

**Think of it! All sins forgiven, the slate wiped clean, that old arrest warrant cancelled and nailed to Christ's cross.**

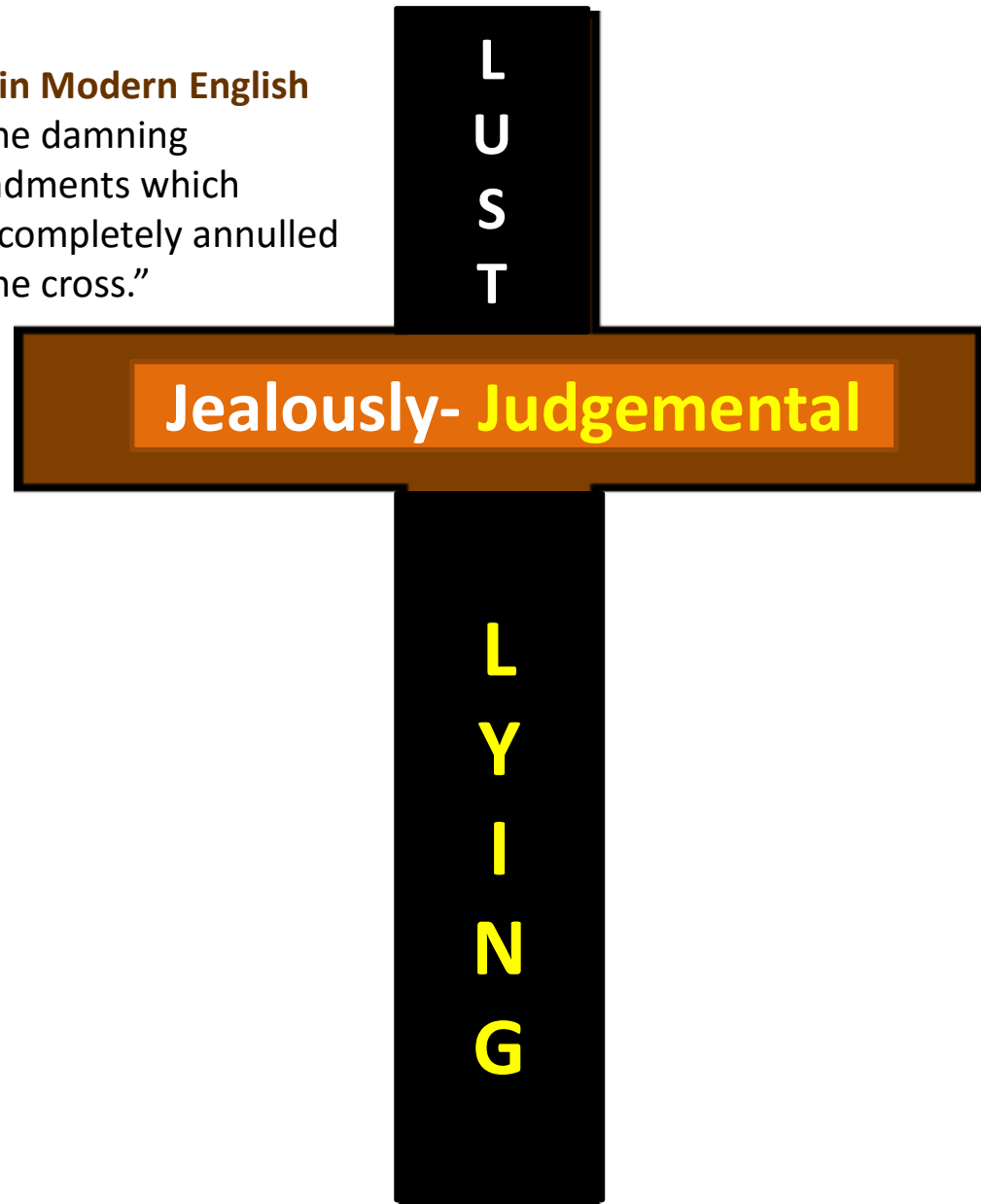


**Colossians 2:13-15 (GW)**

He did this by erasing the charges that were brought against us by the written laws God had established. He took the charges away by nailing them to the cross.

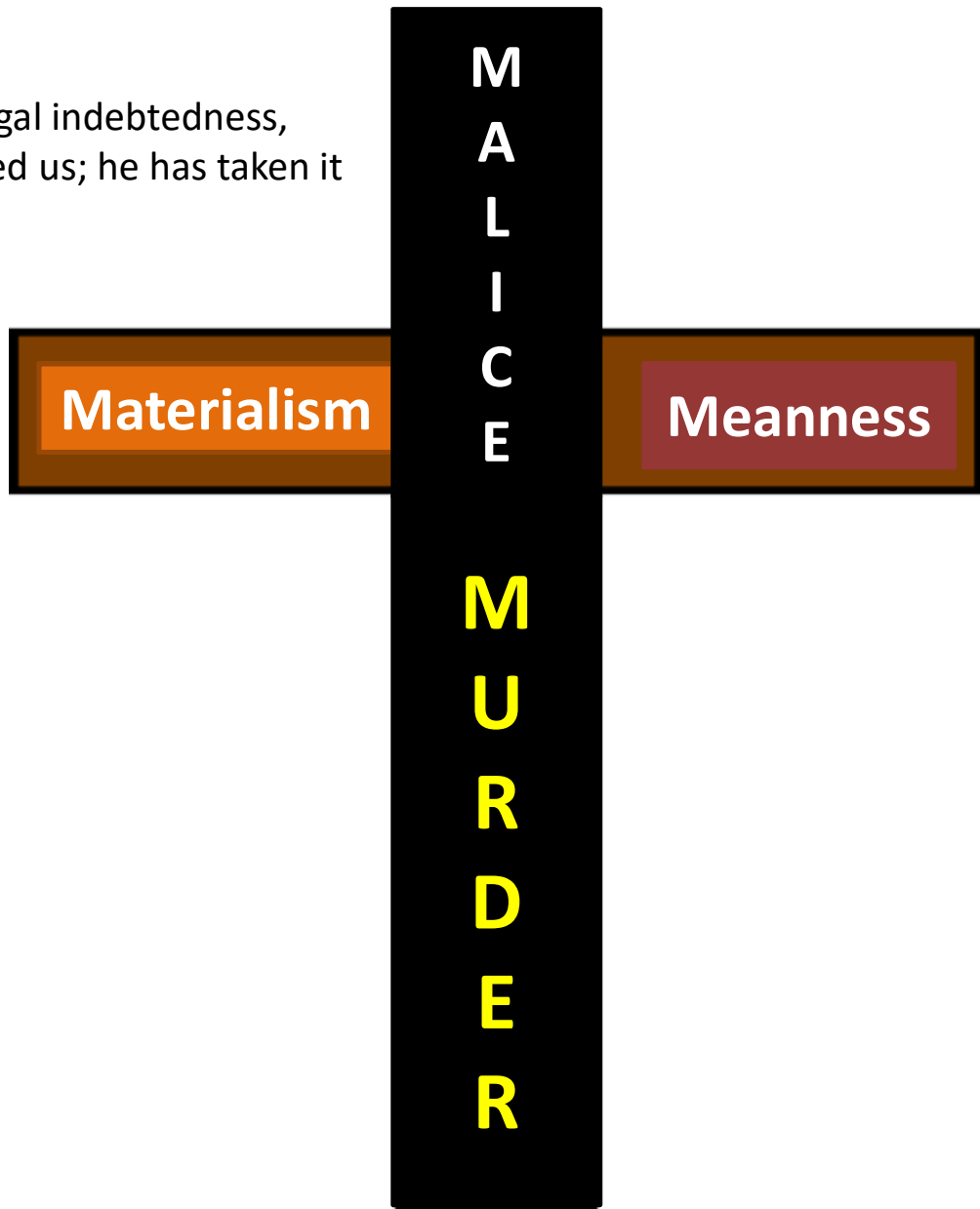

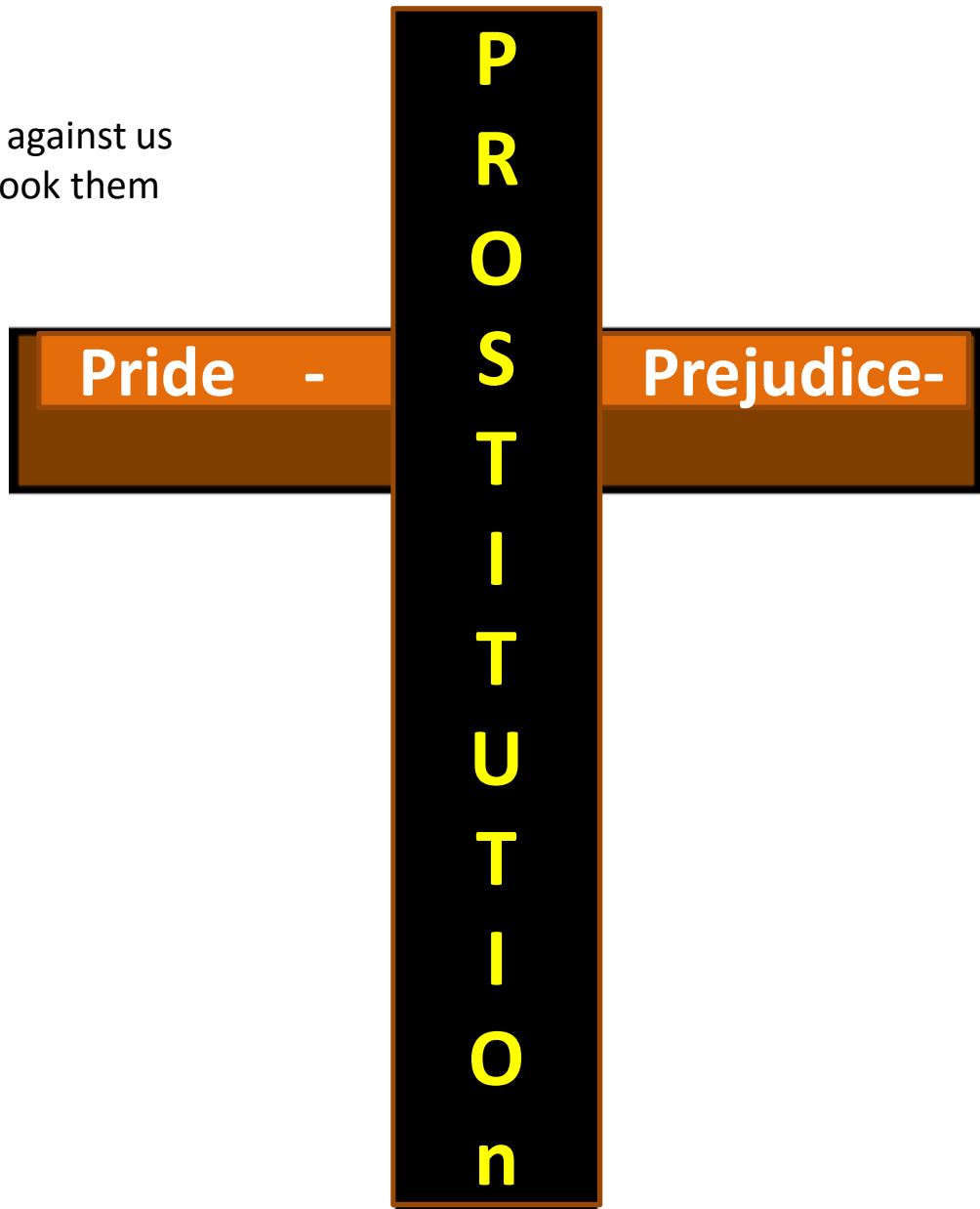
Colossians 2:14 (NIV)

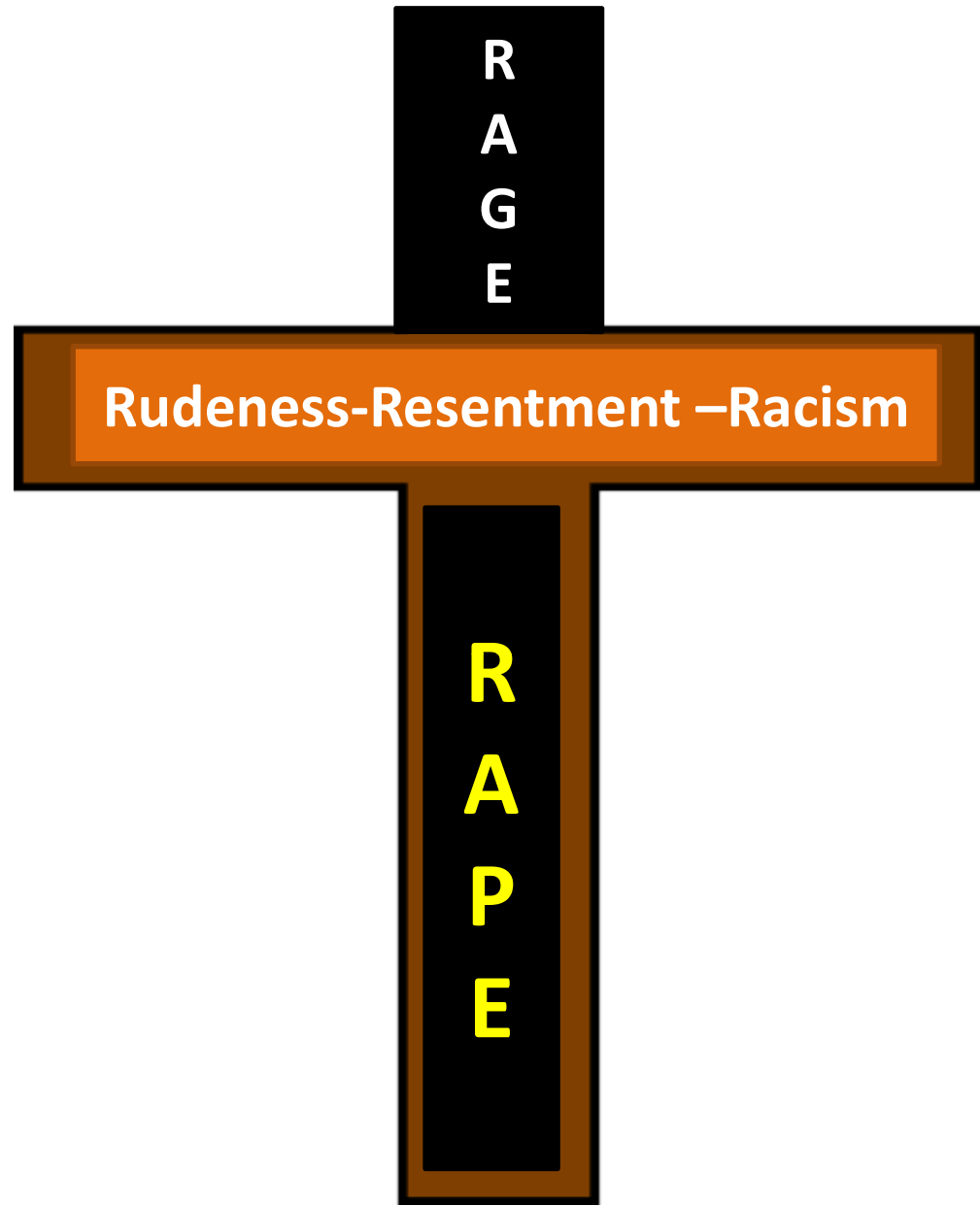
Having cancelled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross

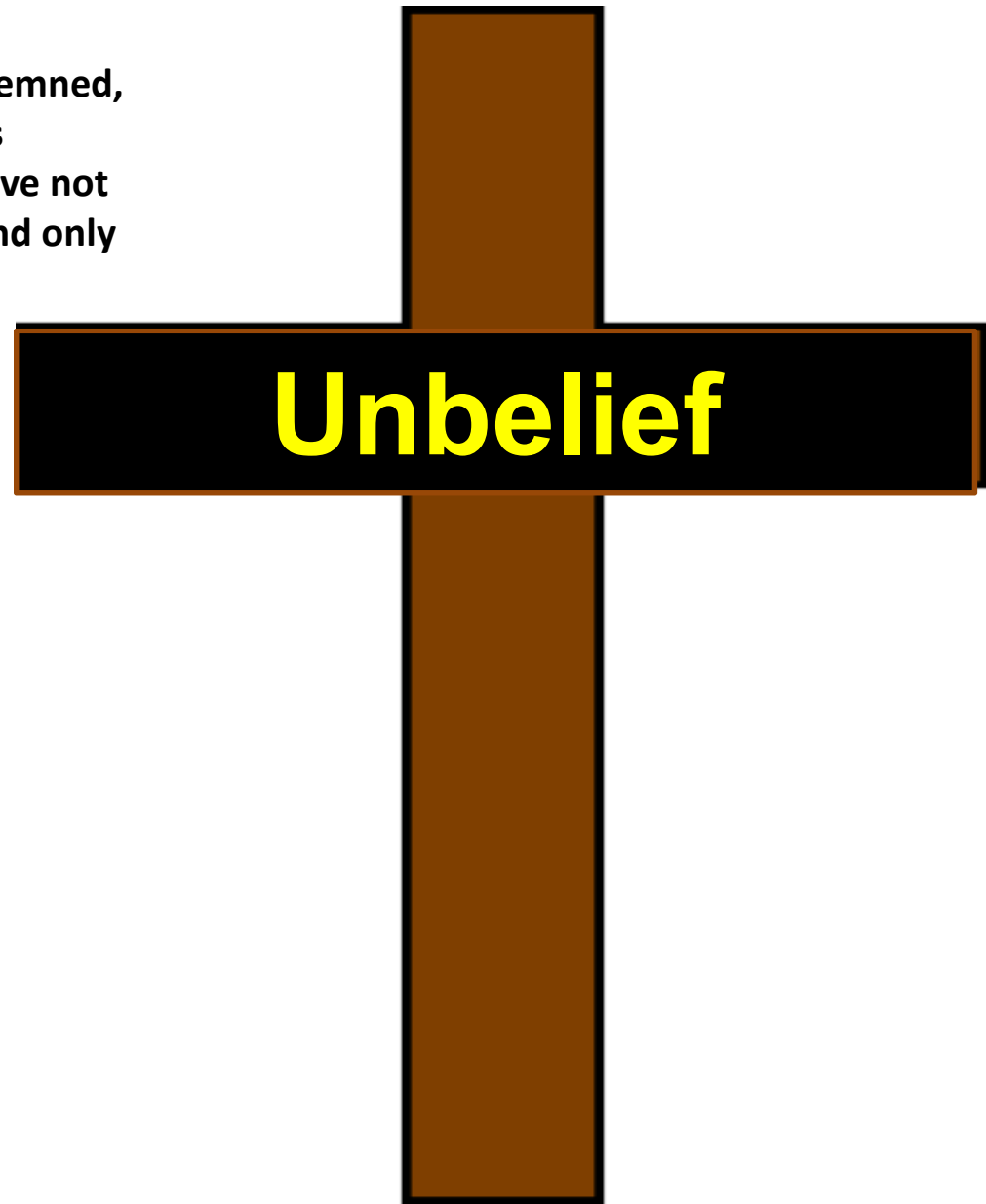
