- Confusion: I don't know who or what to believe any more? (So, I quit)
- In all the years of ministry the two biggest obstacles to overcome...

Analysis?

- Twofold problem... Foolish & Slow
- Could that be our problem ... we believe some "truths" but not all?
- No difficulty in believing some truths, but very slow to believe others?

RELEVANT?

- How many people do you know who have walked from church because of....?
- How many people do you know who have stopped attending church because they no longer know…?

SOLUTION?

- Revival ... Encountering the risen Jesus in a new way
- Have Scripture come alive to us ?
- Having Hope Restored
- Be Quick To Believe
