- ▶ ¹⁹The Son of Man on the other hand, feasts and drinks, and you say,
- ▶ 'He's a glutton and a drunkard, and a friend of tax collectors and other sinners!'
- ▶ *But wisdom is shown to be right by its results."*

Who's to say who's right and who's wrong...?

“Wisdom is proving right... by her actions”

Matthew 11: 19

Well...

- ▶ **(1)** *Well in my opinion.... He's a strange ...dare I say a weird character*
- ▶ **(2)** *I think his not playing with a full deck ... mentally unstable just look at his wardrobe and his diet ?*
- ▶ **(3)** *he's a mad man ... Demon possessed*

What's your opinion of that fellow ...John The Baptist?

Well Think Again ...

- ❑ When John came, he didn't eat or drink as you do. And people say, ' He has a demon.' **Matthew 11:18- (NIRV)**
- ❑ I can guarantee this truth: Of all the people ever born, no one is greater than John the Baptizer. **Matthew 11:11- (GW)**

Well I Think ...

*¹⁹ But when the Son of Man came, he ate and drank as you do.
And people say,*

- ❑ **'This fellow** is always eating and drinking far too much.
- ❑ He's a friend of tax collectors and "sinners." '
- ❑ *By wise actions wisdom is shown to be right."*

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- ▶ John came fasting and they **called him crazy**.
 - ▶ I came feasting and they called me a lush, **a friend of the riffraff**.
 - ▶ Opinion polls don't count for much, do they?
 - ▶ **The proof of the pudding is in the eating.**" MSG

How will we know who got it right ?

- ▶ " But a man is proved to be wise by what he has done.'
- ▶ " Well, Wisdom will be vindicated by her actions—*not by your opinions*
- ▶ God's wisdom, however, is shown to be true by its results
- ▶ Well, the proof of wisdom is in the actions it produces." CJB
